

CONTEST RULES: AllTurf Gift Card Giveaway (“Contest”) from 8:00a.m on August 1, 2018 EDT to 1:00p.m. on January 9, 2019 (“Contest Period”)

1. HOW TO ENTER

To enter the Contest: Contestants are automatically entered for a chance to win when they register for the 2019 Ontario Golf Course Management Conference. Conference registrations must be received by 1:00pm EDT on January 9, 2019. Limit of one entry per person.

Contestants may register

2. ELIGIBILITY

Contest is open to attendees who register for the Ontario Golf Course Management Conference, and who fulfil the criteria of OGSA Classes, A, B, C, D, F. The person named on each conference registration is considered the ‘contestant’ regardless of who is responsible for registration payment. Suppliers, sales representative members, employees of OGSA, are not eligible to participate in this contest.

PROCEDURE FOR AWARDING PRIZES

The winners will be drawn from all eligible attendees on January 16, 2019 at the day’s wrap up. The draw will be done by an OGSA representative, and an AllTurf representative

The first selected contestant to claim the prize in person and answer the mandatory mathematical skill-testing question shall be declared the winner, subject to meeting all the conditions described in these rules. If a winner is not present to claim their prize, incorrectly answers the mathematical skill-testing question, declines the prize, or fails to sign the required release form, the prize shall be forfeited and OGSA has the right, at its sole discretion, to select another winner until both prizes are claimed.
