Position overview:

- ✓ The Environmental Coordinator is a full time, year round position.
- ✓ He/she is responsible for the care and maintenance of the golf course, completing safe and accurate fertilizer and chemical applications and conducting thorough record keeping.
- ✓ With more responsibility than a typical Spray Technician, this person is responsible for ensuring the Club's environmental sanctuary status with Audubon International and works closely with the West Vancouver Streamkeepers.
- ✓ The successful applicant will be fully involved in the fertility and chemical programs at Capilano, making this role perfect for someone who has the goal of becoming an Assistant Superintendent.
- ✓ This person is a key member of the Capilano Technical Team.

Course Information: Capilano is a private 18 hole facility located in beautiful British Columbia. Constructed in 1938 by esteemed Canadian golf course architect Stanley Thompson, Capilano is continually ranked in the top 10 golf courses in Canada by Score Golf Magazine and ranked in the top 50 golf courses in the world outside the United States by Golf Digest. The golf course was voted the #1 golf course in Canada for 2018 at the World Golf Awards. Capilano is open to play year round, with the majority of the 32,000 rounds/year played between April and October. Capilano is committed to continually restoring and improving the golf course. Over the past several years, a Course Long Range Master Plan has been in place to renovate and restore the course. A new staff Maintenance Facility was constructed in 2011, and the construction of a new Fleet Maintenance Facility was completed in early 2017. Our high performance team is comprised of over 35 employees who love to work outdoors, enjoy being in the company of others, and who take pride in their work.

- ✓ A degree or two year diploma in a turfgrass related field from a recognized college or university is preferred
- ✓ Desire to succeed and exceed standards at an intensely maintained golf course
- ✓ Willingness to learn and aid in implementing new programs
- ✓ Efficient use of computers
- ✓ An understanding of golf and how it relates to our operation and membership
- ✓ Valid driver's license
- ✓ BC Pesticide License or the ability to obtain one within first 30 days of employment

- ✓ Perform precise, safe, and timely chemical and fertilizer applications while keeping accurate records and inventory of all products
- ✓ Research product pricing, liaise with suppliers and order products as needed to ensure sufficient inventory is available for scheduled applications
- ✓ Work directly with the Course and Grounds Leadership team in the prioritization and scheduling of all applications to the golf course
- ✓ Thorough scouting of pests and pathogens on all playing surfaces
- ✓ Compose weekly environmental reports
- ✓ Aid in the supervision and training of the Intern(s) and Assistant Applicators
- ✓ Maintain all components of the Clubs IPM program
- ✓ Carry out any assigned tasks to a high standard and in a timely and efficient manner, while ensuring the safe use of equipment and materials
- ✓ Act as an ambassador of the Course and Grounds Department within the Club and as a representative of the Club at professional outings
