The OGSA has developed this scholarship program to recognize the scholastic accomplishments of students who are the children or grandchildren of members of the OGSA (open to all members) and are studying a **post secondary curriculum unrelated** to Turfgrass Management.

## **FUNDING:**

Funding is available to Diploma or Degree students currently attending a University or College program. **Two awards will be presented in denominations of \$2000 and \$1,500.**

## **TO QUALIFY:**

- The applicant must be enrolled in a post secondary institution on a full time basis.
- Applicants chosen field of study must be unrelated to Turfgrass Management.
- The applicant must be a child or grandchild of a member of the Ontario Golf Superintendents' Association.
- The applicant must list his/her parent or grandparent (OGSA member) on the application and current academic advisor, both of whom may be contacted by the committee.
- The applicant must submit their **most recent university or college transcript** with their application form and two essays (250 words each).

*Essay # 1: Describe the steps you have taken or plan to take to prepare yourself towards your chosen career.*

*Essay # 2: Tell us about your (grand)parent's involvement with the OGSA and golf and explain how they have inspired you in your own career ambitions. Describe your own perceptions about the profession.*

## **JUDGING CRITERIA:** Points will be awarded for:

### Essay #1

- Spelling and grammar
- Captures the interest of the reader
- Clearly addresses the topic
- Displays leadership potential
- Shows the motivation to succeed
- Displays diverse interests.

### Essay #2

- Spelling and grammar
- Writing style
- Clear answer to each question
